Likewise, how does the Bissell carpet cleaner work? Carpet cleaners use a combination of clean solution, powerful scrubbing brushes and vacuum suction. Carpet cleaners inject a mixture of cleaning solution and water deep into your carpet fibres. Brushes then agitate, scrub and loosen the dirt and/or stain and then the powerful vacuum suction lifts it away. In respect to this, how do I bring my carpet back to life? Matted carpet can easily be brought back to life. Spritz a little warm water onto the matted area then gently blow-dry with a hairdryer as you fluff the carpet fibres back into place with your fingers, the edge of a spoon or a hairpin. Allow the carpet to dry completely before walking on it.How do you use the Bissell turbo brush? Use | How to Videos | Pet Hair Eraser® Turbo To turn the vacuum on, plug it into a grounded outlet and press the Power Switch to the ON position. Next, turn the brush roll switch ON to use the Power Brush for carpet cleaning. For bare floors, you'll want to make sure the Brush Roll is OFF. To start, first unplug and turn off your machine Your clean tank might be empty, and will need to be refilled First remove the clean water tank by lifting it straight up and away from the lower body Flip the tank so the cap is up and remove it by twisting counter clockwise Now fill the tank with warm tap water to the water fill line Then fill the rest of the tank with the correct formula to the formula fill line Replace the cap then tighten by twisting clockwise Now place the clean water tank on the back of the unit. You will hear a click when it is in place The lint screen on the clean water tank cap may be clogged Remove the clean water tank by pulling straight up and away from the lower body Now remove the cap by twisting counter clockwise Soak the cap in warm water Then rinse the cap under running water The spray nozzle may be clogged First, remove the collection tank by pulling up and out on the latches on both sides of the tank. Carefully remove the tank by lifting up on the tank carry handle To remove the nozzle, with the collection tank off the unit, gently pull the two tabs that point up near the front of the unit. This will help ensure you've drained all the water.)All in all, I like my little Bissell PowerForce. I've had it for a year and it hasn't had any problems. I would say this product is best for people who need mild to moderate carpet cleaning. For those who want the best cleanliness, in terms of this product's power, you may want to clean with it twice a week. If you have high pile carpets, make sure you go over the carpet at least twice. You can expect your carpet to dry in about 2-3 hours (turn on your ceiling fans and direct the air downward to help speed the drying).The only people I CAN'T recommend this product to are parents of young children and pet owners. You'd really be better off spending a little extra for a more powerful cleaner, especially one that has a steam function. But for the everyday user, this Bissell is great.
