St. Patrick Celebrated annually on March 17, the feast commemorates the death of the holy owner, which took place over 1,000 years ago during the fifth century. But our modern celebrations often seem a cry away from the beginning of the day. From the green dying rivers to pinch each other not to give the traditional shade of the day, these customs of St. Patrick, and the general evolution of the day, have no doubt helped him to endure. But, to celebrate, we are retracing the fascinating origins of the holiday. Known as the patron saint of Ireland, Patrick was born in Roman Britain. At the age of 16 he was kidnapped, slave and taken to the island of Emerald. While he fled, St. Patrick is accredited to return to Ireland and bring Christianity with him around 432 A.D., which is probably why the country's national apostle was made. As happens after death, a number of legends have been cut out around the saint. The most famous? Presumably, he led snakes from Ireland, chasing them at sea after they attacked him during a 40-day fast. Did the Christian missionary really accomplish this task? It is unlikely, according to Nigel Monaghan, custodian of natural history at the National Museum of Ireland in Dublin. "There has never been any hint of snakes in Ireland at any time," said Monaghan National Geographic. "There was nothing San Patrizio called." Another story (very more plausible) notes that St. Patrick used a fragment to illustrate the Holy Trinity — from which the three-leaf link with the holiday. To celebrate the life of St Patrick, Ireland hasAround the IX or X century with religious services and parties. From March 17th it falls during Lent - a Christian season that prohibits the consumption of meat, among other things, the travelers attended the church services in the morning and celebrated the saint in the afternoon. Now, the fashion shows are an integral part of the party, especially in the United States where millions of people crowd at the more than 100 fashion shows held annually throughout the country. When the great pruned Famine hit half of the 1800s, almost 1 million Irish emigrated to the United States. In particular, the green also represented Irish Catholics who rebelled against Protestant England. And, as you may know from the past days of St. Patrick's Day, there's also a long tradition of getting pinched for not wearing green. This potentially annoying trend began in the United States. "Some say [the color green] makes you invisible to elves who pinch you if they can see you", ABC News 10 reports. Our advice? Make sure you wear something green on the day or practice your dodging maneuvers until you become a regular Spider-Man. "Many traditions of St. Patrick originated in the United States", Mental Floss points out. "Like the urge to dye everything green, from our spirits to our rivers".
