This isn't your typical soft play cafe. Step inside Hopscotch Play Cafe on Gosforth High Street and you'll find a stylish venue with a bar where parents can relax with a drink while their children play. Offering everything from coffee to cocktails, the unique idea has proved to be a hit with families across Newcastle since it opened in September. Mum-of-three Cyrenne Khaliq-Fleming, 42, is behind the new soft play venue which caters to little ones aged from three months to around six years old. "It is a soft play cafe aimed at pre-school level but there is a bit for older kids as well with an arcade machine and an outdoor space," she said. "We have fitted it out to be more appealing to adults so there is a full bar and the decor is really neutral with no primary colours that you would usually see in soft plays. We have a full menu with breakfast, brunch and lunch options and a grazing board-style menu for Friday evenings. "You can also hire the place out for parties. It is going really well. It is constantly busy and we are fully booked for parties until February next year. "I think everyone is enjoying the fact that you can go somewhere and have nice coffee and food while your kids are entertained. The layout means you are watching them all the time and know they are safe. "After spending more than a decade working in London, Cyrenne returned home to Newcastle with her family and felt that there weren't many soft play cafes in the Gosforth area so decided to launch her own. She bought the unit in March last year and has worked with Tigerplay to transform it into a stylish play area. The venue now hosts around six parties every weekend and offers a drinks and catering package for adults. The most popular drinks include an espresso Martini, Margaritas, and Aperol Spritz, priced at 9. Hopscotch also offers a breakfast, brunch and lunch menu which features favourites like Moroccan slow-cooked beef and mozzarella ciabatta, chorizo and potato hash and a 'Gosforth Grill' (English breakfast). There's also a kid's menu as well as a range of cakes and desserts. "It has a nice atmosphere and the parents love it," Cyrenne said. "I didn't know how people would take having a bar with kids but people are sensible, no-one goes crazy. It is just a little added bonus."Parents are urged to book in advance online. A two-hour slot for children aged three months to under one is 4.95 and children aged one to five cost 6.95. The venue also runs regular events and currently has a Santa's Grotto with sessions that can be booked online. Hopscotch Play Cafe is open seven days a week from 9am. With a sleek design, cosy caf and a well-stocked bar, the latest addition to Gosforth's High Street has put itself firmly on the map with local parents. Cyrenne tells us about the journey to creating Hopscotch. Im originally from the North East and my family are involved in leisure and hospitality up here. I moved to London after uni and was there for 14 years working in finance, Ive had three kids and moved back, she tells us. Ive got three under eight now, and just noticed there was a bit of a gap in the market. Having lived in London, theres quite a lot of these play cafes and other stuff for kids, but I noticed you have to travel to find them here, and particularly there wasnt much in the city centre. Not one to shy away from a challenge, Cyrenne took it upon herself to fill this gap. A unit came up on Gosforth High Street and I thought it would be a good idea to set something up. I spent a lot of time at soft plays, so I had an idea of what people like and dont like, she explains. So basically Hopscotch is like a boutique-style soft play. I just wanted to set up somewhere where adults can enjoy it as well as the kids. Plenty of thought and preparation went into making the interior as stylish and pleasant as possible. We used a company called Tigerplay. They just do a really good job, she explains. We completely rebuilt the unit that wed bought which was once a bank. We used a neutral palette so that it was nice to sit in while the kids are running around. In terms of the caf itself, we set it out really stylishly and we offer really good cakes and coffee. We use all local suppliers, so our coffee is from Morpeth, our cakes are made in-house or from a few local suppliers. We offer full breakfast, brunch, lunch and a grazing menu for kids and adults, and then we have a bar.
