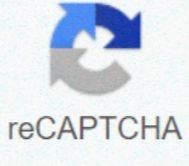

Suddenly small flocks of partridges will fly out of the pine forests, surprising us. Sometimes hundreds of birds can gather, testing our swing, because the biggest difficulty is to concentrate on a single partridge. Check which rules apply to your country. Pernics are hunted in open pastures, where they thrive better. Pernics are monogamous. Unlike pheasants, males have only one female. Pernics find compañeras in spring, but when we meet them during the hunting season they are found in the fields or hedges in small flocks. You usually shoot the pins using a pointer. There are many breeds of dogs that can be used "setter" and pointers, as well as continental breeds such as the German wire-haired and short-haired pointers. The dog seeks underwind and indicates the birds until the hunter arrives. The hunter then instructs the dog to approach the birds so that they take the flight. The hunting of the pernice begins between the end of summer and the beginning of autumn, immediately after the harvest. The temperatures are therefore relatively high. Hunting often covers vast areas, and you run many kilometers in a day. It is therefore important to have anti-humid hunting clothing that are comfortable to wear, so that you can move easily and freely for many hours.
