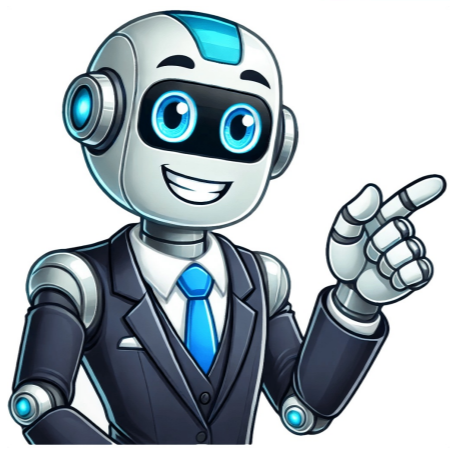

Unico sobrevivente 2027 fake

A "TIME TRAVELLER" who claims he is in the year 2027 has posted a series of videos to prove he is "the last person on Earth" after his followers on TikTok accused him of being a fake.Javier, who goes by the name @unicosobreviviente [only survivor] has been sharing bizarre clips of deserted streets in Spain, including one of a secret passageway in an abandoned city.4If you make the same video in the day I will believe you" a TikToker said4Javier shared a clip with a view of Barcelona4He also posted a clip of himself dressed in black clothes and trainersThe Tiktoker says he is the only survivor on Earth after a mass extinction but some of his over six million followers are doubting his claims and have branded him fake.Over the weekend one of his followers challenged him to film a video with a view of Barcelona, from the last floor of the hotel the TikToker is staying.Javier did so but then was challenged by another follower to film the same clip during the day: "If you make the same video but during the day, I'll believe you for real".Another TikToker commented: "Look closely at the dark spots in the intersection you can see some movements, Looks like something was edited out.""Your hands are different on each video," someone else said.And in a bid to prove he is telling the truth Javier posted the same video in the daylight.The short clips filmed from above starts with a view of an empty crossroad in the city- parked cars can be seen but no traffic or people are around.He then lifts the camera and shows a view of the city under a cloudy sky."Waking up, everything changes place" Javier said."I am trapped between 2021 and 2027. I am in a world parallel to yours.Last week,Javier decided to film a short video of himself for his non-believing followers. The Tiktoker, dressed in a black hooded jacket and trainers holds his phone in front of his face to hide his identity and slowly zooms in.But many of his followers are still not convinced and continue to suggest new challenges.Someone said: "How can you send a TikTok from the future to the past using internet from there, is the frequency of the wave go (sic) between time and space and dimension?""I dare you to go to Egypt at the pyramids," someone else commented.One said: "Wow he owns an Iphone 11 Pro in 2027."Another user added: "He hide his face because he knows that will be the end of everything."4Javier claims he lives in the year 2027TikTok time traveller "ears he trapped in the future ALONE as he shares footage of secret passage in abandoned city>We pay for your stories!Do you have a story for The Sun news desk? A man claiming to be a time traveller stuck in the year 2027 is determined to prove sceptics wrong with his latest post, in which he shared eerie footage of a deserted city in a bid to show he's the "last person on Earth. "TikToker Javier (@unicosobreviviente - which means "only survivor") has racked up over 6m followers through sharing his solo adventures as a "time traveller" by filming abandoned places, buildings and cars. He's even previously warned that human extinction is just a few years away.But of course, people have their doubts over the TikToker's outlandish claims, believing it to be fake and that he is simply visiting places when they are quiet.@unicosobrevivienteResponder a @diegg0r1 So, now Javier has directly responded to a commenter who asked for further proof by posting footage of his view from the top floor of a Barcelona hotel he's currently residing in. The clip filmed in the daytime shows what usually would be a busy city junction, but in Javier's video it's completely empty - and so looks pretty abandoned as he described."Waking up, everything changes place" Javier added in the comment section."I am trapped between 2021 and 2027. I am in a world parallel to yours. "Though despite hitting back at critics with the clip, many still didn't believe the TikToker's story and were pointing out a number of discrepancies within the video.One person wrote: "It's obviously a video from back in lockdown when no one was out.""My garden gets overgrown in less than a week but all the landscaping here remains perfect with no tending. ..." another person said. "Amazing how the traffic lights are still working," someone else added. "This was taken during lockdown, everywhere was like a ghost town.""How did the red car get parked there? In the night video there is no red car," a fourth person replied.Meanwhile, sceptics were also quick to point out that a bird appeared to survive whatever disaster supposedly happened on Earth as it was spotted flying in the sky within the first second of the TikTok.One person wrote: "He forgot to edit the bird.""There is a bird at the beginning of the video," another person said.Someone else added: "A bird in this one? Hmmm..."Whether you believe Javier or not, either way the TikToker is racking up the views as people point out clues so we guess he's the real winner here.We'll have to wait another six years to see if he's right...Though Javier isn't the only person claiming to be a time traveller on the social media platform. TikTok isn't just the home of dance challenges and viral songs, it's also a hub for conspiracy theories and down right bizarre stories. Case in point, the Last Survivor on TikTok.In February, a mysterious TikTok account (@unicosobreviviente, which translates to Last Survivor in English) appeared from a Spanish man named Javier, who claims to have woken up in 2027 all alone after "humanity had been extinguished". The owner of the account, who already has 1.2 million followers, has never revealed his identity, only referring to himself as Javier in his bio.The account shared its first video on Feb 13, showing the deserted streets of Valencia, Spain, and claiming that there is no human life. He captioned the post: "I just woke up in a hospital and I don't know what could have happened. Today is February 13, 2027 and I am alone in the city."He also commented on the video: "I'm reading everyone now, it's very cold on the street, I've tried to go where I lived and I didn't have keys to stay, what would you do in my situation?" Since then, Javier has shared multiple videos showing himself walking through abandoned streets, empty clothing stores and deserted beaches. People have also requested videos in certain locations to prove he is in fact the last human on earth. Although there's apparently no human life anymore (he hasn't actually revealed how all humans had become extinct), everything else has remained in tact, including freshly washed cars and a clothing shop with all the clothes still neatly hanging up. Although the Last Survivor's videos seem incredibly realistic, some have questioned if Javier is actually stuck in 2027. It's also possible because of the coronavirus pandemic that the streets are a lot quieter than usual making it possible for Javier to film, or he could have just edited people out.Some eagle-eyed TikTok commenters have also spotted some references to the present day in Javier's videos. In one clip, he strolls around the deserted city and heads to the cinema. One of the movie posters outside looked like it was for Wonder Woman 1984, which was released in December 2020. In another clip, Javier goes into a deserted apartment. Although humans have apparently been made extinct, there's not a speck of dust on the tables or chairs.Hm.Other unanswered questions are how are there footprints in the sand on the beach? How are there ships on the water if there are no humans? Why are the cars so clean?Javier has since claimed that everything he sees is still in 2021 but he is in 2027. He said: "I want to clarify that I am in 2027 but everything I see and where it is stayed in 2021. I think I woke up in 2027 as a parallel reality. And I just remembered my name." Huh? A man who claims to be stuck living in 2027 has shared eerie "proof" that he's the only person left alive.The man says that he is a time traveler from three years in the future and has shared footage of a deserted city in order to prove his claims.Known as Javier, the man has been posting videos on TikTok as @unicosobreviviente - which actually translates to 'only survivor'. His shots of a supposed empty Spanish city have earned him a massive following of nearly 10 million people.According to Javier, he's stuck alone in the year 2027 after the rest of the world's population was wiped out by a disaster.Uploading the videos as proof, the TikToker walks down empty streets and shows views of deserted areas.However, viewers of the footage are quick to critique, with many being skeptical to what they're seeing.Some have argued that Javier is purposely filming these locations during quiet parts of the day so in response, he captured a video of what should be a busy city junction that is now a ghost town.But that isn't fooling many, with some people suggesting that he is editing or manipulating the footage to make it appear empty when it's actually not.Taking to the comment section, one unconvincd user wrote: "Look closely at the dark spots in the intersection, you can see some movements. Looks like something was edited out."Another wrote: "Your hands are different on each video."The TikToker is facing doubters on the social media platform (TikTok/@unicosobreviviente)While a third person asked: "How can you send a TikTok from the future to the past using internet from there?"Does the frequency of the wave go between time and space and dimension?"The supposed time traveler captioned the video with: "Waking up, everything changes place. I am trapped between 2021 and 2027. I am in a world parallel to yours."In one video, he is walking down an empty Paris street with the Eiffel Tower visible in the background and in other clips he appears to be traveling around different European countries.This has led many viewers to question how he's moving around so easily if he's the only human left.One person wrote: "Wait but can someone explain how he's getting to these places if there's no other people... he's a pilot?"Another responded with: "Also, how does he get fuel to drive?"This prompted a tongue-in-cheek reply from another viewer who suggested: "With AI." The man, who calls himself Javier, wrote: "I just woke up in a hospital and I don't know what could have happened. Today is February 13, 2027 and I'm alone in the city. I am the only survivor."Since then, Javier aka "Único Sobreviviente" ("The only survivor") has been traveling around trying to convince his followers that there will be no other people besides him in 2027.Whether in places that are usually crowded with tourists at any time of day, forbidden places like the Vatican , on a cruise ship or in shopping centers: the Spaniard has been everywhere and always seems to be alone.As if the lonely situation wasn't depressing enough, the supposed time traveler always accompanies his videos with the appropriate music. On TikTok , for example, more than 9.7 million users now follow the Spaniard, who apparently lives in a parallel universe that is connected to the present in some way, which is why Javier is able to provide his followers with regular posts. He has also dared to make a few prophecies, such as the hurricane in South Carolina in September 2021. But are TikTok and co. actually witnessing a time traveler here? Empty soccer stadiums, cycling through a shopping center: it seems there are no limits for Javier. © Bildmontage/Screenshot/TikTokunicosobreviviente In his photographs, you can see completely empty places that are otherwise flooded with people. © Bildmontage/Screenshot/TikTokunicosobrevivienteEven though the videos of the "sole survivor" are really well made and have great entertainment value, critical voices are raised under each post by users who don't believe Javier's story one bit.After all, watching the videos raises logical questions, such as how he manages to move so effortlessly and quickly between the many European countries. Some users are also keen to spot image errors that reveal that the footage was edited before it was uploaded.It is also noticeable that the electricity and internet still work in every location, there are fresh footprints on the beach and the public advertising is up to date. The vegetation in the cities also appears to be well maintained, and the grass in the soccer stadiums has not grown out of control. It is also more or less obvious that the videos of Javier are merely staged and that the other people have been cut out with the help of an AI. Nevertheless, the insight into a deserted world is always exciting! In February 2021, the human race — already shaken by global catastrophes, political turmoil, and the arrival of a Pentagon UFO report that could blow the lid right off everything we thought we believed — received an unexpected visitation that set the whole internet alight. Well, that set TikTok alight. Or part of it, at least. On the 13th of the winter month, a user by the name of @unicosobreviviente — which is Spanish for "lone survivor" — posted a video of deserted streets and stores in Valencia, Spain, and claimed that there was no sign of human life anywhere. "I just woke up in a hospital, and I don't know what might have happened. Today is February 13, 2027, and I am alone in the city," the user, who gives his name only as Javier, wrote in his first post. Many were intrigued, if not convinced, by Javier's footage. Certainly, the otherwise bustling city of Valencia seemed entirely lifeless, and as Javier posted more videos, it seemed less and less likely that the user had just managed to fluke a few minutes of footage of unpopulated streets one especially quiet morning. And the videos kept coming. What exactly is going on? As Javier's posts continued throughout 2021, his world became more clear. "I woke up alone in a hospital in Valencia (Spain). I couldn't remember my name or where I lived. I decided to go outside and there were no people. Everything was like in 2021, but the electronic devices showed 2027. I discovered that there was a connection between 2021 and 2027. People in 2021 could see the objects I left in the city, but people couldn't see me and I couldn't see them. And a few days ago I found a letter telling me that I am the JESP8827 experiment." he wrote in one post titled "MY STORY." Sure, some users were, of course, joylessly skeptical. Why were there human footprints on the beach, for instance? How come there was no dust when Javier explored abandoned apartments? How was his Wi-Fi working? Why was everything so tidy? Others, however, wondered how Javier — look, speller alert, he's not a time traveler from 2027, OK? — managed to get such uncanny footage of deserted Spanish landmarks day after day, month after month. Javier's account now boasts over 6 million followers, and the user regularly engages with his fanbase by encouraging them to post questions and requests and to find the treasure that he sends back to 2021 from his abandoned future world. Para dar um ar de mistério e veracidade na sua história de viagem no tempo, e de ser o único sobrevivente da Terra, Javier faz vídeos em vários lugares diferentes, onde aparece completamente sozinho nas ruas. Com isso, muitos poderiam pensar que ele teria gravado os vídeos durante o "lockdown" em 2020. No entanto, ele sempre grava vídeos atendendo a pedidos de fãs nos comentários ("grava no lugar X" etc.). Assim, na verdade o que ele faz é apenas gravar os vídeos normalmente, e depois ele edita usando o programa de edição After Effects, da Adobe. Comece a lucrar com o seu perfil no TikTok em 30 dias Como mostrado no vídeo acima, os vídeos do Javier 2027 são editados no programa Adobe After Effects, utilizando a função "Content-Aware Fill". Essa função é parte integrante do "Project Cloak", que é uma ferramenta experimental da Adobe para remover objetos indesejados dos vídeos. Pela qualidade dos vídeos que o Javier posta em seu TikTok, Instagram etc., podemos ver que essa ferramenta do After Effects é muito poderosa. É a tecnologia nos surpreendendo cada dia mais! He only recalls waking up wearing a bracelet and nearby there were some documents with him.This document shows the name of the hospital and a date posted 10/02/2021. Several passages from what is shown on the letter, say something about an order and urgency. The document also says he arrived at the hospital unconscious. The name of the hospital is Hospital General Universitario da
