The house was commissioned by the family through a letter written by Willey’s wife asking Wright who designed a “art creation” by about 8,000 dollars. . It is an example of the concept of the Usonian house of Wright and is the only Wright building in Alabama. Some of him’s buildings are obviously the design of him, but there are others who do not seem to have had anything to do with him. The house includes other style characteristic elements. Gale House and was built on a speculative basis for the neighbor of Wright, Walter Gale, in 1892. The construction of the building began in 1937, and the building expanded during the next 25 years to become what it is today. The original owner of the house, Emil Bach, was co-owner of the Bach Brick Company and a great admirer of WrightcAAAs work. The house reflects the influence of Japanese design, which Wright strongly admired. The house includes numerous tiled terraces and built-in furnishings incorporating WrightcAAAs polygonal modules that create a more open flow.The Romeo and Juliet Windmill cAAA Wyoming, WisconsinWright designed this wooden structure for the town of Wyoming, Wisconsin.
